Meeting Minutes

February 6, 2024 National Housing Center 1201 15th Street, NW, Washington, DC 20005

Call to Order

The 2024 NGBS Consensus Committee held its third meeting of the 2024 NGBS Update on February 6, 2024, at the National Housing Center in Washington, D.C. Chairman Robert Ross convened the meeting and Kevin Kauffman, Coordinator of Standards and Testing at Home Innovation Research Labs, took roll. See Appendix A for a list of meeting participants.

Introductions and Opening Remarks

During the roll call, each member of the committee briefly introduced themselves.

Approval of Minutes

2024 NGBS Consensus Committee Motion: Approve Minutes from November 8-10, 2022 Meeting.

Maker: Karla Butterfield Second: William Sanderson

The motion was carried unanimously via voice vote.

Overview and Orientation

Kevin Kauffman presented and discussed the process and the procedures for the meeting. (A one-pager with the Basic Rules and Procedures for the meeting was emailed to the committee prior to the meeting and was also available to all members at the meeting.) The hearing order, process for the Consent Agenda, and voting protocol were discussed in detail.

Consensus Committee Review of Proposed Changes

A version of the Consent Agenda with actions on each item removed from the consent agenda as recorded at the end of the meeting can be found in <u>Appendix B</u>.

The Consensus Committee adopted a Formal Action (Accept, Accept as Modified, or Disapprove) on each of the 152 Public Comments that were received on the 2024 National Green Building Standard Draft 1. The Consent Agenda items were voted on in blocks by section. Prior to addressing each section Robert Ross asked if anyone present (member or guest) would like to remove any items in that section from the Consent Agenda. Each Public Comment removed from the Consent Agenda was introduced and opened to the committee for discussion. The discussion on each item removed from the Consent Agenda, which potentially included testimony from whomever removed the item, was followed by a motion and resolution by the entire Consensus Committee. Once each Public Comment removed from the Consent Agenda had been acted on, a consensus committee member moved to accept all Task Group Recommendations for items on the Accept & Accept as Modified

Consent Agenda for that Section. Following this action, a consensus committee member moved to accept all Task Group Recommendations for items on the Disapproved Consent Agenda for that section. This process was repeated for each section. The meeting was open to the public and visitors were provided with an opportunity to address the committee.

2024 NGBS Consensus Committee Motion: Point system in draft standard be open for public comment.

The motion was carried unanimously via voice vote.

2024 NGBS Consensus Committee Motion: Carry-over accepted changes in Sections 1-10 to mirrored versions in Sections 11 and 12.

Maker: Theresa Weston Second: Michael Cudahy

The motion was carried unanimously via voice vote.

Review of the 2024 NGBS Update Process & Next Steps

Kevin Kauffman provided an overview of the next steps in the process including the concurrent letter ballot on initial Formal Actions and Second Draft Standard, public comment period, and processing of public and ballot comments.

Scenarios which would trigger an additional meeting were discussed and was tentatively planned to occur via teleconference.

Adjournment

Robert Ross thanked everyone for their participation, hard work, and commitment to the improvement of the National Green Building Standard. The meeting was adjourned by Robert Ross at 5:00 pm.
